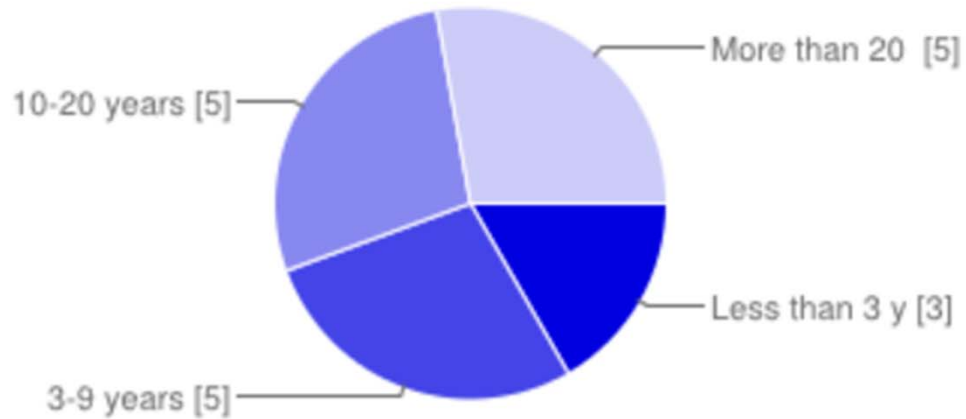

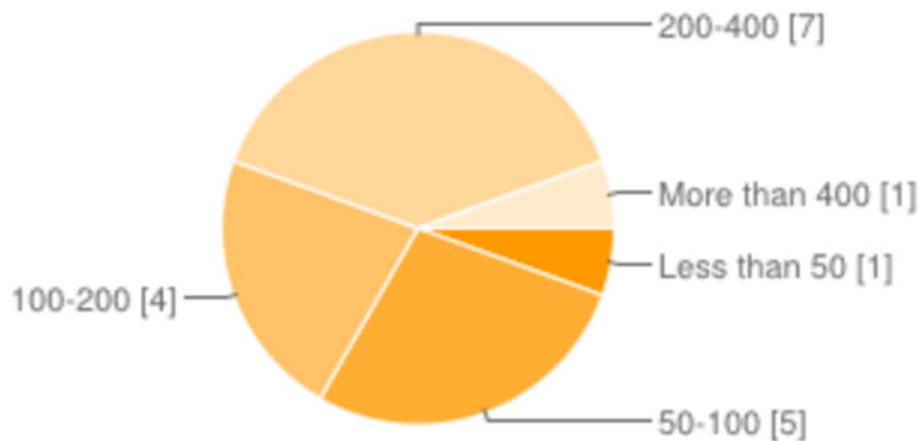

Years of university teaching experience



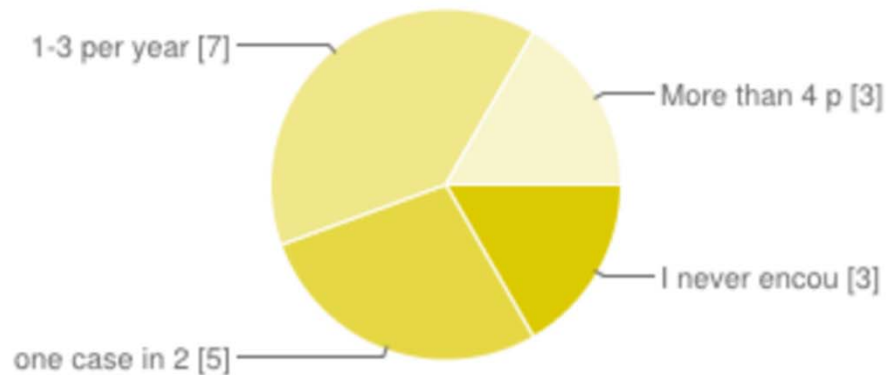
Less than 3 years	3	17%

More than 400	1	6%

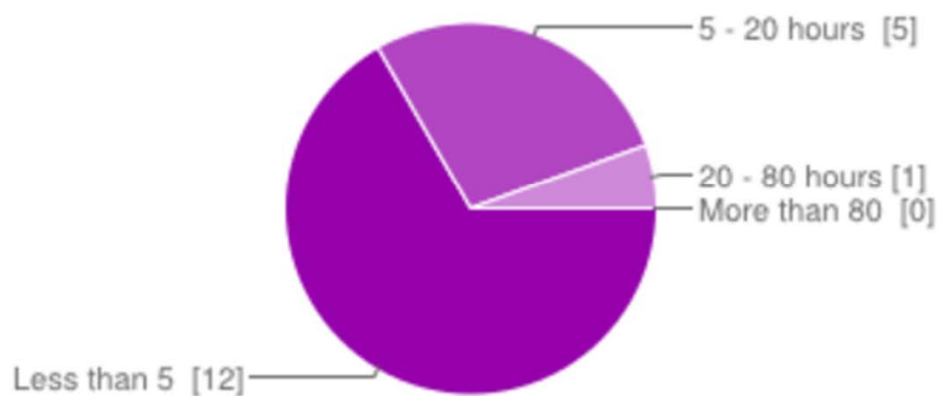
How often do you encounter plagiarism cases?

More than 4 per year	3	17%

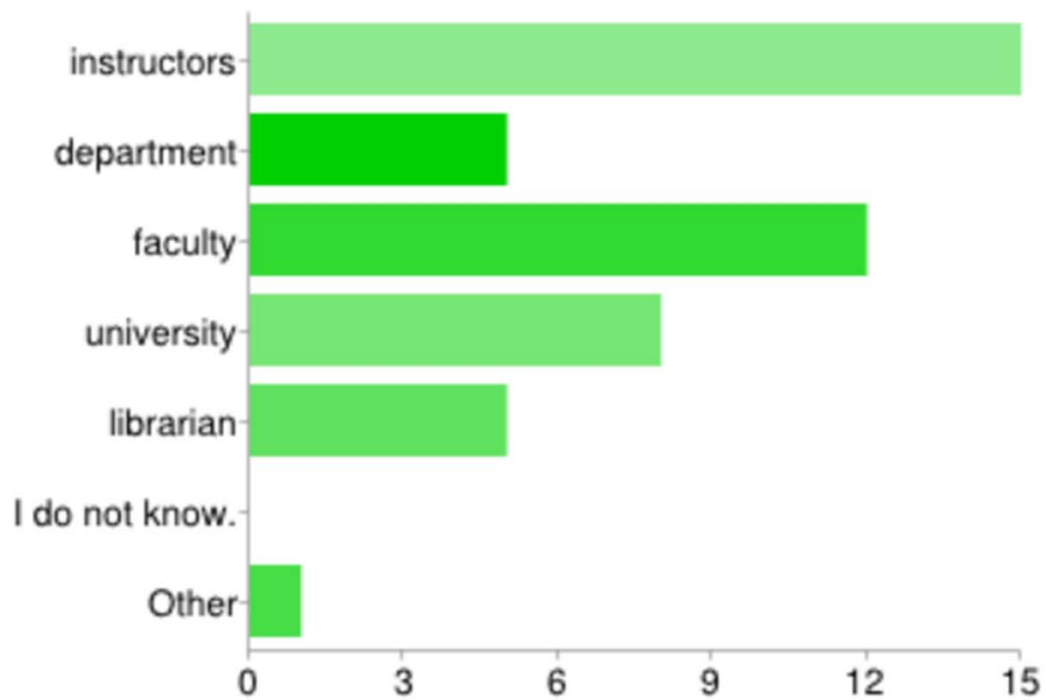

How much time do you spend on plagiarism issues?



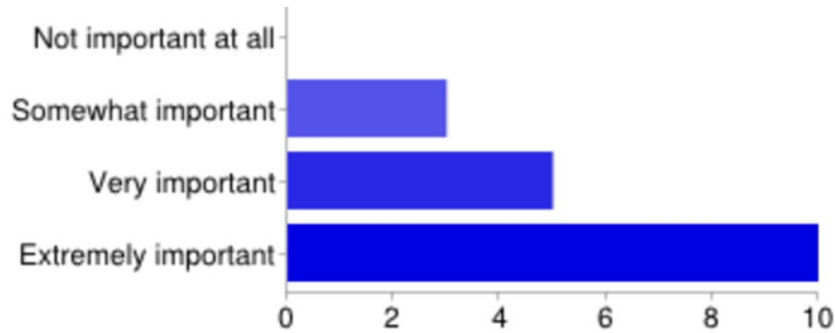
Less than 5 hours per term.	12	67%

At your institute, who educates your students about plagiarism?

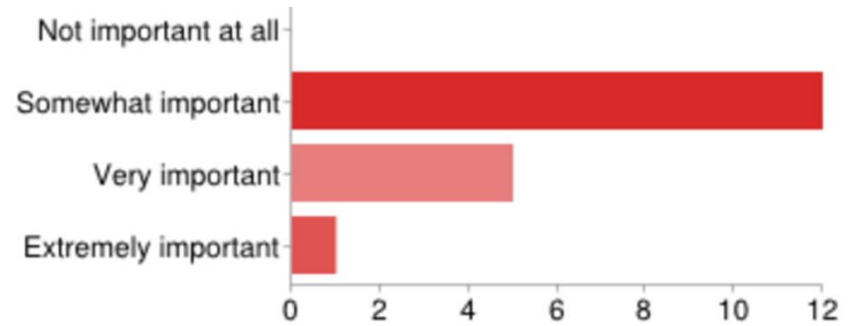


What should we do to deter plagiarism?

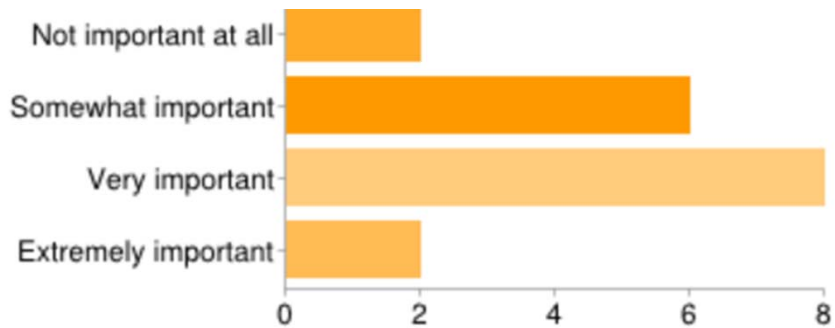
Educate students about plagiarism.



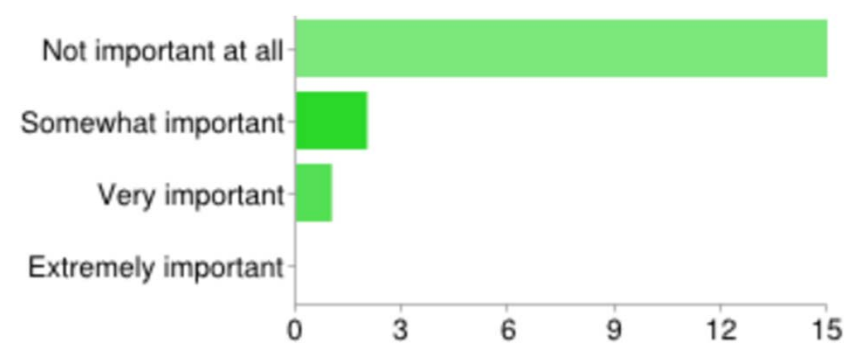
Give stricter sanctions.



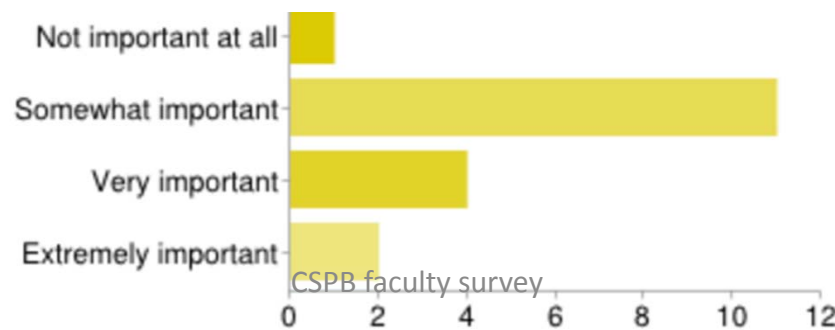
Avoid assignment that can be plagiarized easily.



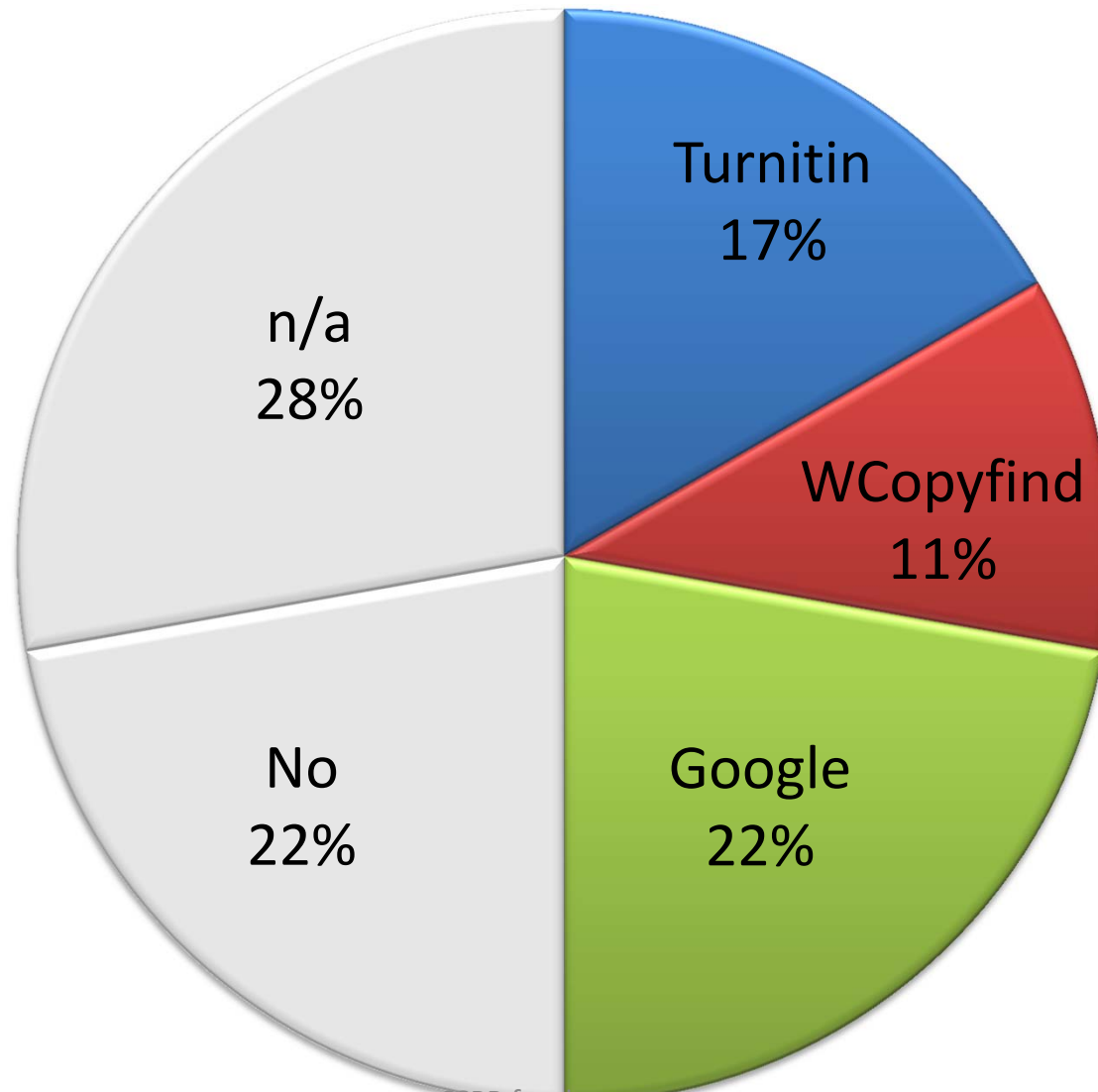
Reduce the number of assignments.

Do you use plagiarism detection software?

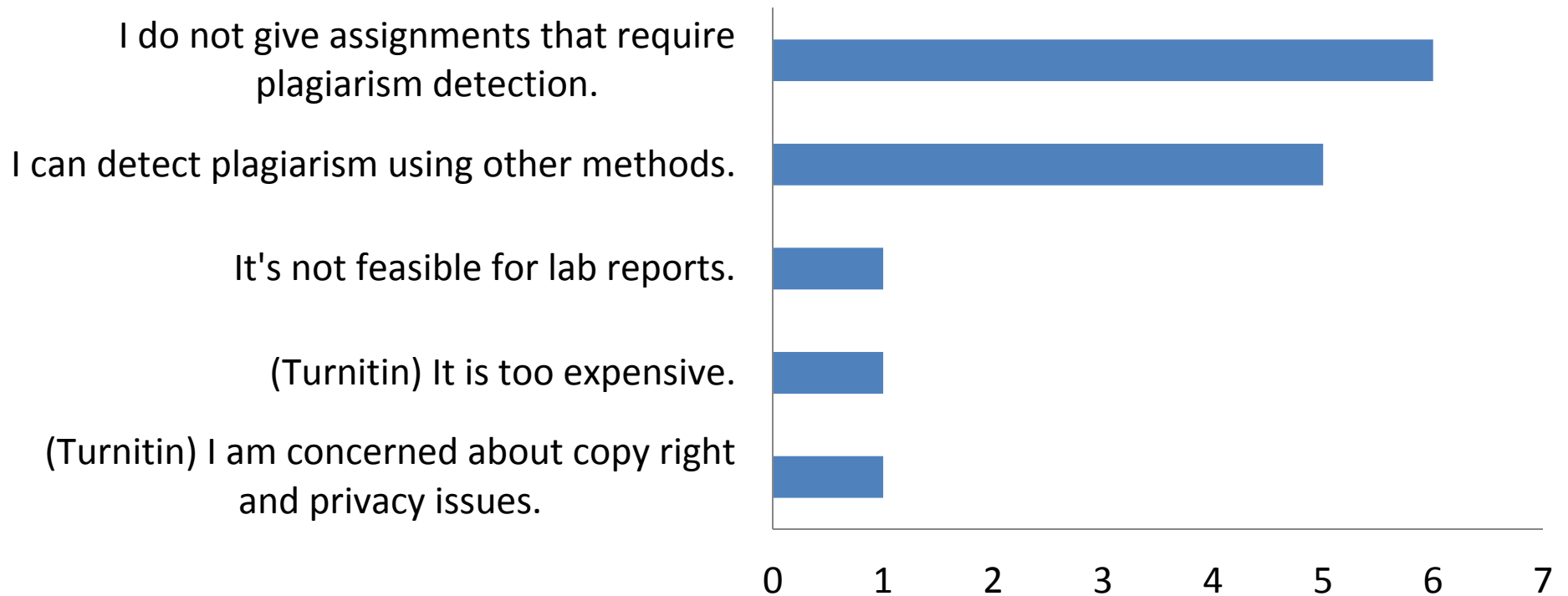

Why do you use a detection software?

Why do you not use a plagiarism detection software?



A student submits a lab report that contains several paragraphs lifted from another report submitted in the previous year. This is the first time offense. The report is worth 10 % of the final grade.

Zero grade on the plagiarized section.	2	11%
Zero grade on the report.	11	61%
Zero grade on the report & additional reduction of the grade.	1	6%
Grade of F for the course.	0	0%
Other	4	22%

Other:

- Penalize the student for x% and redo the report.
- Hand back the report, do it again.
- In addition I would talk to the student.
- Zero grade on the report, reporting issue to department and administration
